





Entrance to large tipi




External view | Ø 5.00 m or Ø 6.50 m

We offer our 3 tipis of various sizes at the various rates:

Persons 14 years and over:	€ 16.50	pers. / night*
Children aged 2 to 13:	€ 11.50	pers. / night*

This includes: car, electricity, hot water in the showers and washrooms and waste disposal fee.

ADDITIONAL COSTS:

Deposit:	€ 50.00	one-off
Health spa tax:	€ 1.50	pers. / night (aged 16 and over)

ARRIVAL / DEPARTURE:

Arrival / check-in:	from 2 p.m.
Departure / check-out:	by 11:30 a.m.

Amenities:

Type I: 2 small tipis. diameter 5.00 m (= sleeps up to 6), power socket, light
Type II: 1 large tipi. Diameter 6.50 m (= sleeps up to 15), power socket, light

Bring your own:

sunbeds, air mattresses, thermal mats, sleeping bags,
bedding (blankets, pillows), towels etc.



Our recommendation for you:

The tipis are not 100% closed at the top where the poles meet in order to ensure optimum ventilation. If it rains, the minimum amount of dripping water which enters is centrally on a cord attached for this purpose, as well as on the poles of the inner wall of the tent.
