

CAMPSITE RULES

Upon arrival, we kindly ask you to present your identification card, even if you are only visiting the campsite for a short time.

The campsite fee is payable upon departure from 7:30 AM or, upon request, on the day before departure until 5:00 PM. The required information for fee calculation must be provided at the reception upon registration.

For the duration of your stay at our holiday park, vehicle entry and exit can be managed via license plate recognition. When parking motor vehicles, motorized two-wheelers, caravans, and tents, please follow the instructions of our staff.

We strive to make your stay as pleasant as possible but rely on your cooperation by following our campsite regulations.

Our campsite is located in a protected natural area. Please refrain from cutting or breaking off branches from trees and bushes, as well as removing rare plants that thrive exclusively along the shores of Lake Constance.

Please be considerate of other guests and avoid disturbing noise. Radios, televisions, and other devices should always be kept at a low volume. During **nighttime quiet hours (10:00 PM – 7:00 AM)**, loud conversations should also be avoided.

During this period, vehicle movement within the campsite is strictly prohibited. Arriving guests must park their cars in the designated night parking area. We also ask for your cooperation in observing the **midday quiet period from 12:00 PM to 2:00 PM**, even during arrival and departure.

The campsite management reserves the right to enforce campsite regulations. Violations, unreasonable disturbances to other guests, or damage to the campsite may result in immediate expulsion.

The use of cars and heavy motorcycles should be limited to essential trips only and must be **driven at walking speed**. **The use of mopeds, small motorcycles, quads, electric scooters, and electric bikes is strictly prohibited within the campsite.**

We expect all guests to maintain the same level of cleanliness that we strive for. Sanitary facilities should be left in the same condition as found. Small children may only enter sanitary and toilet facilities under adult supervision. Please follow our waste separation system and use the designated recycling bins for glass, cans, and paper, as well as general waste containers.

Dogs must always be kept on a leash within the campsite. Please ensure that pets do not contaminate the camping grounds. Dogs are allowed on the beach and in the water but not in the main bathing area.

All wastewater must be collected in appropriate containers and emptied only in designated disposal facilities within the sanitary buildings.

Digging trenches and fencing off campsites is not permitted. Please ensure that tent pegs, ropes, and other camping equipment do not pose a hazard to others. We do not accept liability for puddles caused by heavy rain. Open fires are strictly prohibited. **We are not responsible for lost or damaged items due to fire, water, storm, accidents, or injuries, including boating or surfing accidents.**

Swimming in the lake is at your own risk.

Boats may not be stored on the beach in front of the campsite. Motorboats are strictly prohibited within a 300-meter shoreline zone, except for direct access and departure at a maximum speed of 5 km/h. **Please observe storm warnings and all legal regulations when engaging in water sports and fishing.**

Before leaving, please check out at the reception. Departure must be completed by 12:00 PM. **For rental accommodations, check-out is required by 10:00 AM.** Late departures may incur an additional overnight fee. Please leave your campsite clean upon departure.

The campsite management has the right to enforce rules, deny entry, or expel guests if necessary for the safety and comfort of others. Legal action may be taken if required.

Merchants and individuals conducting business activities on the campsite are not permitted entry.

To maintain a good relationship with neighboring spa towns, please be mindful when visiting the nearby tourist areas of Langenargen and Kressbronn. **Avoid excessive noise, especially in the evenings after visiting restaurants. Moped and motorcycle riders are asked to respect the nighttime driving restrictions in the cultural centers of Langenargen and Kressbronn.**
